<u>Kindergarten</u>

In kindergarten we have started to work on steady beat and getting to know each other! We have moved, sang, and played instruments.

Ask your child about "Busy, Busy, Bumblebee".

First Grade

In first grade we have started to get to know each other with our hello song! We have also reviewed steady beat and begun to listen for the difference between 1 and 2 sounds.

Ask your child about, "Yankee Doodle".

Third Grade

In third grade we have started to work on the pentatonic scale. This is the modality we will be focusing on all year. We have sung "The Canoe Song" in pentatonic and done a home tone improve!

Ask your child about, "You're a Grand Old Flag".

Second Grade

In second grade we have begun to review our known rhythmic notes. We have also begun to listen for the difference between 3 sounds in a song.

Ask your child about, "This Land is Your Land".

Fourth Grade
